

Day 1Sat 25 FebArrive BeijingOn arrival in Beijing, please make your own way to the
hotel. Welcome dinner tonight.(Dinner)

Day 2Sun 26 FebBeijingVisit Cuandixia Village, for a tantalizing glimpse of the old
China.(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 3Mon 27 FebBeijing-Taiyuan-Mt. WutaiTake bullet train to Taiyuan from where travel by coach toMt. Wutai. En route visit Foguang Si Temple (The Templeof Buddha's Light).(Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 4 Tue 28 Feb Mt. Wutai Full day explore Mt. Wutai, literally, 'the five terrace mountain', a sacred Buddhist mountains. Visit Wuye Temple, Tayuan Temple and Pusa Peak. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 5 Wed 01 Mar Mt. Wutai-Pingyao Coach to Pingyao. On arrival, free to explore the old town on your own. We stay in Pingyao for four days to explore many outstanding attractions nearby, including an old town, a large family home as well as the old city itself. (Breakfast/Lunch/Diner)

Day 6 Thu 02 Mar

Explore the ancient city walls and streets, visit sites like the Qingxu Daoist Temple, the Chenghuang Miao (Temple of the City God) and the Wen Miao (The Confucius Temple). (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 7 Fri 03 Mar

Visit the Wangjia Dayuan - The Wang Family Courtyard Housing Complex, a collection of civil residential architecture in an ideal Siling Feng Shui model, about 35 km away from Pingyao. Visit Shuanglin Temple, featuring attractive, colourful sculptures, and a UNESCO world cultural heritage site. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 8 Sat 04 Mar

Take a day excursion to Chunyang Gong, a Daoist shrine, Shuangta Si (Twin Pagoda Temple) with two 53meter-tall pagodas standing in it, hence the name, and Jinci Temple, a prominent temple complex in Shanxi. (Breakfast/Lunch/Dinner)

Day 10 Mon 06 MarPingyao-BeijingTake high speed train to Beijing. Upon arrival, transfer to
hotel, then free time shopping and sightseeing according
to individual tastes. Farewell dinner tonight.

the airport.(Breakfast)
